Violation of the provisions of this Chapter is a misdemeanor punishable as provided in Section 5-1-33. (Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)

5-6-1. Definitions.

In addition to the definitions set forth in Section 5-1-2, the following words and phrases used in this Chapter shall have the meanings herein prescribed:

Home occupation: Any business activity entered into for profit and conducted or operated from or in residential premises within the City. (Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)

5-6-2. License required - Display.

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in a home occupation without first securing a license therefor.

The licensee shall conspicuously display such license in his place of business so that the same is plainly visible to the public. (Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)

5-6-3. Procedure.

Applicants for a license required by this Section must obtain permission for the issuance of a home occupation permit from the City Building Inspector. The Building Inspector shall review each request in view of the definitions of permitted home occupations as outlined in Section 7-2-19 of the Tooele City Code. Upon presenting an approved permit from the Building Inspector to the Recorder, the applicant shall receive from, fill out and file with the Recorder a business license application as required under the provisions of Section 5-1-3 et seq. The provisions set forth in said Section shall be controlling as to all matters relating to the requirements for and issuance of a license, license fee, exemptions, renewals, etc. (Ord. 87-24, 01-02-88; Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)

5-6-4. License fees.

License fees for licenses issued pursuant to this Section shall be the same as set forth in Section 5-1-10. (Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)

5-6-5. Inspections.

The City reserves the right to inspect any premises licensed for home occupation which present a potential danger to the public health, morals or welfare but does not require all such premises to be inspected. (Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)

5-6-6. Zoning requirement.

Home occupations shall comply with all zoning requirements as set forth in Title 7 of the Tooele City Code. (Ord. 87-24, 01-02-88; Ord. 83-22, 12-07-83)
