WATER DEPOSIT: Your deposit is a security deposit and will be retained until you close your account in writing. It will then be applied to your final bill. Any excess will be refunded to you.

SET UP FEE: There will be a \$30.00 set up fee whenever an account is set up in your name. This charge will appear on your first billing as a **SET UP Fee** charge.

WATER CHARGES: The water billing is a combination of 2 fees:

1. Base fee dependent upon the size of your meter, and
2. A usage fee based on the amount of water used. The more water used, the higher the cost per unit of water (one unit of water equals 100 cubic feet or approximately 750 gallons).

SEWER CHARGES: The sewer billing is a combination of two fees:

1. Base fee of \$7.00,
2. A fee as to the amount of water used during the winter months (usually November thru March which normally accounts for internal water use only). The fee is \$2.00 per unit per month. **An average rate of \$27.00 will be charged to all new customers, until a rate can be established upon the next winter's usage period.**

STORM WATER UTILITY: The rate structure is based upon the following parameters:

Single Family residential home (including duplexes)	\$3.00 per home or unit per month
Multiple Family units (HDR zone of 16 units per acre)	\$2.10 per unit per month
Commercial Property (<1 acre)	\$10 per month
Commercial Property (1-5 acres)	\$25 per month
Commercial Property (5-10 acres)	\$50 per month
Commercial Property (10-15 acres)	\$75 per month
Commercial Property (>15 acres)	\$100 per month

GARBAGE PICK UP: There will be an \$11.00 per month charge for garbage pick up. Service is provided by Ace Disposal. Any Questions on garbage pick up should be directed to them at 882-7009. Problems with the city provided cans should be directed to the Tooele City Finance Dept at 843-2150.

BILLING: Bills are sent out the 1st of the month and should be received by the 6th. Bills are due by the 15th and will include all of the above charges.

Only garbage in the city provided containers will be picked up. The container is the property of Tooele City, however; you are responsible for its care and cleaning. Please keep it free from destructive or decorative markings. Please do not place ashes or other hot materials in the container. If you do so you will be charged for the replacement. Each container has an identification number that is assigned to the residence. **DO NOT USE THE CONTAINER AT ANY OTHER LOCATION.**

The cost of garbage collection services is:

Additional containers will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. The minimum time for keeping an additional container is 4 months. When returning a container it must be washed out before it will be picked up.

On garbage pickup days, place the container at the edge of the street next to the driveway, opposite your mailbox, to insure easy access by the automated hauling trucks. Do not block driveways or roadways. The container's wheels should be close to curb or edge of the road with the lid hinge to the curbside and the lid opening facing toward the street.

Do not overfill the container to the extent that the lid does not remain firmly closed or to such an extent that the contents may be spilled during the process of pickup and dumping.

Container must be out by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled pickup day. Remove the container from the street as soon as possible after being emptied. The only days garbage will not be picked up are Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. On these weeks, service will be delayed one day starting with the holiday.

TOOELE CITY BULKY WASTE PROGRAM

Tooele City provides a bulky waste pickup program. The pick up day will be once a month for those items that do not normally fit into your garbage container. This service is being provided at no additional cost to Tooele City residents and will go a long way in cleaning up our city and keeping it clean. The guidelines for pickup are as follows:

Pickup day: Bulky waste will be picked up from the curb in front of each home one day each month, that day being in conjunction with your normal pickup day. The pickup schedule is:

Normal Garbage Pickup Day

Monday
Tuesday
Wednesday
Thursday & Friday

Bulky Waste Pickup Day

1st Thursday of each month
2nd Thursday of each month
3rd Thursday of each month
4th Thursday of each month

Please BAG, BUNDLE, or BOX items for this pickup. If items are not prepared properly they WILL NOT be picked up.

Bulky waste service is year round depending in weather (if rains or snows, no pick up). Due to Thanksgiving Day, the last pickup in November will be on Friday. Your bulky waste should be placed curbside the day before pickup day. Leaving bulky waste curbside for longer periods of time is unsightly and will subject you to the illegal dumping ordinance.

SIZE & WEIGHT: The driver loads the bulky waste by hand. Therefore bagging, bundling, or boxing is **required**. Boxes must be 30 gallons or smaller (DO NOT set out boxes in wet weather). Bundles of limbs must be less than 18" diameter, less than 5 feet long, and weigh less than 75 lbs.

If materials you put out are improperly prepared, it will not be picked up.

APPLIANCES & FURNITURE: This service provides for the curbside collection of old appliances, furniture, and carpet including couches and mattresses. Get them to the curb and they will be removed (ITEMS WITH FREON MUST HAVE THE FREON REMOVED AND THEN A LABEL PLACED ON THE ITEM INDICATING SUCH REMOVAL). Questions? YARD TRIMMINGS & LIMBS: Generally, anything you can get inside your cart should go in there. If you trim your trees or clean out the garden and occasionally have too much yard waste for your can, we can get it on bulky waste day. Everything except large limbs (larger than 4" in diameter) must be bagged bundled or boxed. Loose piles of yard trimmings and limbs won't be picked up. Remember, these bundles must be less than 5 feet in length & weigh less than 75 lbs. If you are in between pickup days, always remember that the Tooele County Solid Waste Disposal Facility will take **green waste for a fee of \$3.00 per load** (Rates as of July 1999). RUBBISH (WOOD, PLASTICS, METAL, LEATHER): If you clean out the garage, basement or closets and have a box of old worn-out junk to get rid of, put it out on bulky waste day and Ace will pick it up. Remember, this service is intended to help with those once or twice a year cleanup projects. Our intention is to containerize all of our weekly waste. If you consistently have more than you can get in your cart, you need to obtain a 2nd can.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION WASTE: Construction and demolition waste generally won't be collected on bulky waste day. Although, if you box up the leftovers from last weekend's

homes improvement project, we'll take them. If you just tore down that old shed in the backyard, you need to make arrangements to take it to the landfill. If you need more information regarding the Tooele County Solid Waste Disposal Facility, please call 833-9520.

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE: All of the normal, everyday household garbage you generate (like food waste and packaging) must be disposed of weekly in your big green cart. The State Health Department requires that garbage be collected weekly. If you consistently generate more than you can stuff into the cart, we'll bring you a second cart for an additional \$5.50 per month. You can request an additional container by calling 843-2150. We will not pickup extra garbage outside the cart on your normal collection day or bulky waste day.

GRASS CLIPPINGS: You can get rid of grass clippings by composting them in your backyard or by buying a mulching blade for your lawn and just leaving them on the lawn. If you don't leave the grass too long between mows, it won't leave a mess. If you want to dispose of your clippings, put them in a bag. Leaving a bag of grass clippings lying around in the hot summer sun waiting for bulky waste collection day conjures up visions of awful sights and smells. **GRASS CLIPPINGS ARE NOT TO BE PUT OUT FOR BULKY WASTE COLLECTION.**

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: Paints, oil, solvents, bug spray, weed killer, batteries, old car parts, fertilizers and such are considered household hazardous wastes and **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.** You can get more information about their collection by calling (435) 277-2440.

OTHER PROHIBITED ITEMS: Any kind of waste from businesses, tires or piles of brick, broken concrete or dirt will not be collected. For more information on disposing of these materials call Tooele County Solid Waste Disposal Facility at 833-9520.

RIGHT OF REFUSAL: The bulky waste collector has the discretion to refuse items which do not meet these guidelines or that which he believes will pose a risk to human health
