The band's high-energy performances celebrate the best of the great American music tradition from swinging standards to funk-laden grooves. Under the direction of Caleb Chapman the band has already performed with dozens of GRAMMY-winners and over 100 other celebrity musicians. Notable guest artists have included Jeff Coffin (Dave Matthews Band), Steve Smith (Journey), Lenny Pickett (Saturday Night Live band leader), Gregg Bissonette (Ringo Starr), Chester Thompson (Genesis), Karl Hunter (Big Bad Voodoo Daddy), and local favorites Kurt Bestor, Thurl Bailey, Sam Cardon, and Governor Jon Huntsman, Jr.</p> <p>In 2008 the band was recognized as the top organization in Arts and Entertainment by Utah's Best of State.</p>
June 12	7:00 pm	Kerry Christensen	<p>Kerry Christensen is not your typical yodeler. His concerts and events this year will take him to as many as 23 US states and two or three countries internationally. Kerry spent two years in the country of Austria right out of high school where he became interested in the alpine yodeling art. After mastering this difficult medium he was asked in 1983 to move his six member family to Orlando, Florida and use his yodeling skills at Walt Disney World's Epcot Center. He performed there for almost seven years until 1990.</p> <p>Today Kerry performs all kinds of corporate, festival, and community concert events. He recently lent his unique classical yodeling talent to a full-length Disney animated feature called "Home on the Range." Kerry is perhaps the only full time yodeler in the world that specializes in all styles of yodeling. He can be strictly alpine, or he can put on his Stetson hat and do an all-cowboy yodeling show. However, many of Kerry's fans say that their favorite show is when Kerry mixes up the styles. You will hear cowboy, alpine, cajun, Latin, Jewish, Hawaiian, jazz, classical, and his always popular humorous yodeling renditions.</p>
