## Frame and Mat Certification Class

In this class you will cut and assemble your own frame, and cut you a custom 11 X 14 inch mat. Please bring an 8 X 10 inch or less picture to put in the frame. You will also be certified to use the mat cutter. (Adults Only)

### Beginning Pottery

Learn various forms of hand built pottery using clay. This class is for beginning students and no experience required. All supplies and tools will be provided. (Adults Only)

### Soap Making

Learn how to make melt and pour glycerin soap. You will be able to choose your scents, colors, and molds. This class is a great class to do alone, or come as a group of friends. No experience is needed, and all supplies will be provided. (Children welcome to register with a parent.)

**Fee:** \$6 for 12 ounces of soap (participants may also purchase more soap at class)

## Ceramic Certification

Learn to pour and clean a cast ceramic piece. No experience is needed. One piece will be include in your fee. All required firings are also included in the price. Students will need a ceramics tool kit that can be purchased from the Arts and Craft Center for \$5. (Children 10 years and older are welcome to register with a parent.) *Youth groups with leaders can call for group appointments.*

## Handcrafted Watch & Jewelry
